

## **EPA Registered Disinfectants**

The attached is a list of all disinfectant products that are EPA registered effective against Methicillin resistant staphylococcus aureus (MRSA). The list includes the chemical ingredient with the name given to it by the original manufacturer. This chemical may be purchased by other companies and formulated into a product distributed with a name provided by that company. The product found on a shelf may not have the same name shown on the EPA list.

To determine if a product is registered, first look at the label for the product in question. Look for the “EPA Reg. No.” This will be two or three sets of numbers such as: 1234-56-123. The first 2 sets of numbers must match the EPA registered products list. The third set of numbers will be different for each manufacturer that sells the product. If your product is not registered for this purpose, you may find a list of products that are registered. To find a list of products, go to the following website: <http://www.cdpr.ca.gov/docs/label/epanum.htm>. In the box, type the EPA registration number. Remember to check “retrieve active products only”. Click on the submit button and a list of products with the approved active ingredient will be shown. Look down through the list to find a product that you have available through a supplier or through local stores.
